### INTRODUCTION BY **DR. RICCARDO MUSACCHI** AND **DR. FARNAZ FARAHI**

<b>Friday, January 20</b> 9.30 – 18.00	<b>Judy Weiser</b>	How personal photos share their inner meanings — and how to use clients' discussions about photos as open-ended "projectives" for improving the depth and success of their therapeutic sessions.
<b>Saturday, January 21</b> 9.30 – 18.00	<b>Judy Weiser</b>	Therapeutic applications of photos about the "individual self" of the client: Using photos clients take, photos taken of clients by others, and photos they take of themselves (self-portraits), to improve their therapy sessions.
<b>Sunday, January 22</b> 9.30 – 17.00	<b>Judy Weiser</b>	Therapeutic applications of photos about the "relational self" of the client (their role within their family, social, and other systems, their "collective identity" rather than their "individual identity when-no-one-else-is-around") — including family photos and photos of the social and other networks the client is part of.  Additionally, this day will include a small closing discussion about important ethical considerations in using PhotoTherapy Techniques in therapy sessions.
