# Judy Weiser, R.Psych., A.T.R. Founder & Director of the PhotoTherapy Centre



Judy Weiser is a Psychologist, Art Therapist, consultant, trainer, University Adjunct Instructor, and author -- and one of the earliest pioneers of "PhotoTherapy" (and related) techniques. Founder and Director of the *PhotoTherapy Centre* in Vancouver, Canada (in 1982), she is considered the "world authority" on the techniques of *PhotoTherapy, Photo-Art-Therapy, Therapeutic Photography, VideoTherapy,* and *Therapeutic Videography* (*Therapeutic Film-Making*).

Former Editor of the journal *Phototherapy*, Judy authored the classic text "*PhotoTherapy Techniques: Exploring the Secrets of Personal Snapshots and Family Albums*" (now in 3rd printing and with Italian, Korean, and Russian translations), as well as dozens of professional journal articles and book chapters about PhotoTherapy and related techniques (some of which have been translated into Japanese, Korean, Russian, Italian, and German) -- as well as an educational Video/DVD.

Having spent over 30 years using her PhotoTherapy techniques in private practice as a therapist (primarily with socially-disenfranchised clients), she has spent the past 15 years solely doing consulting, lecturing, teaching workshops and conducting training intensives about her techniques, all over the world.

Judy has given over 300 <u>Workshops, Trainings, and Lecture Presentations</u> in over 50 cities world-wide during the past three decades (including being invited several times to teach for Programs in Italy, Russia, Latvia, Poland, Finland, Sweden, Spain, Netherlands, Mexico, England, Scotland, USA, and Canada during the past few years) -- teaching mental health professionals how to use *PhotoTherapy*, *Photo-Art-Therapy*, and *VideoTherapy* techniques to improve their therapy and counseling work with clients.

She has also long taught non-therapists how to use the related techniques of *Therapeutic Photography* and *Therapeutic Film-Making* (intentional photographic activities for improving individual and community well-being, reducing social exclusion, and resulting in positive changes in people and or communities -- as well as methods [and ethical considerations] for using participants' photographs in qualitative participant- or community-based research).

Judy also now teaches the 6-day "Intensive Experiential Training in Judy Weiser's PhotoTherapy Techniques" Certificate Workshop annually in Canada and occasionally in Italy -- and will soon be starting to teach online courses and finalizing her sizeable Archive collection about these subjects.

She created and maintains the primary informational resource and networking website for the field, "<u>PhotoTherapy and Therapeutic Photography Techniques</u>" (where all her publications can be downloaded for free) -- as well as the related Facebook Group "<u>PhotoTherapy, Therapeutic Photography, Photo Art</u> <u>Therapy, and VideoTherapy</u>" (with over 7,000 members).

In addition to the above, Judy is also Adjunct Faculty in the "Masters of Counselling: Art Therapy" Program at Adler University (Vancouver Campus), on the Editorial Board for both the Italian Journal PsicoArt: Rivista on line di arte e psicologia (PsychoArt: Online Journal of Art and Psychology) and the Canadian Art Therapy Association Journal, and is an elected member of both the Canadian Academy of Independent Scholars and the American Family Therapy Academy.

She also serves as International Consultant to the *Center for Visual Therapies* in the U.S., the *Institute for Psychology and Photography* in Mexico, *PSYFoto/PSYForte* in Russia, and *VideoReport* (of *LaDamaSognatrice Produzioni Audiovisive*) in Italy -- and has also been an occasional Instructor for both the *Toronto Art Therapy Institute* and the *Vancouver Art Therapy Institute*.

Judy and her work have been featured in many popular-media publications and she has also discussed and demonstrated her techniques in a variety of radio and television interviews in several countries. Listed in the *Canadian Register of Health Service Providers in Psychology*, she maintains professional license credentials in both Psychology and Art Therapy.

Judy continues to accept contracts to provide education and training in the use of *PhotoTherapy*, *Photo-Art-Therapy*, *Therapeutic Photography*, and *VideoTherapy* techniques in therapy, counseling, and related well-being and healing practices independently, as well as by contract for agencies, treatment programs, educational institutions, rehabilitation facilities, well-being programs, professional associations, organizations, hospitals, etc. -- as well as privately-arranged individualized training -- and also enjoys sharing these techniques with businesses, the public and the media.
